Frances DANIEL was born on 25 July 1845 at Beatties Prairie, Delaware District, Cherokee Nation, IT, now Delaware County, OK (or 25 April).<sup>5235</sup> She died on 29 November 1884 (or 1881).<sup>5236,5237</sup> She was buried at Fairview Cemetery, Vinita, Craig, OK.<sup>5238</sup> He was a Captain under General Stand Watie during the Civil War.<sup>5239</sup>

John B. RAGSDALE was born on 31 January 1839 at Flint District, Cherokee Nation, IT, now OK.<sup>5244,5245</sup> He died on 10 March 1875.<sup>5246</sup> He was buried at Pack-Faulkner Cemetery, Muldrow, Sequoyah, OK. William Shorey PACK was born on 12 November 1841 at Stilwell, Flint District, Cherokee Nation, IT, now Stilwell, Adair, OK.<sup>5247,5248</sup> He died in October 1909 living at Muldrow, Sequoyah, OK.<sup>5249</sup> He was buried at Pack-Faulkner Cemetery, Muldrow, Sequoyah, OK.<sup>5250</sup> Araminta GUNTER was enrolled on the Dawes Roll-Cherokees by Blood roll #3449. William Shorey PACK was enrolled on the Dawes Roll-Cherokees by Blood roll #3448.
